














THE LOGISTICS

- Our Lodge is located on the Marls side of Abaco Island, just a 10-minute drive from the airport. Abaco Lodge is probably the easiest Bonefishing lodge to get to in the world!
- Travel from the US: Numerous direct flights a day to Marsh Harbour. Major carriers that fly directly into Abaco include: Delta, American and Silver Air (a United subsidiary).
- Travel from Nassau: Bahamas Air, Sky Bahamas and Western Air have multiple flights a day.













FACILITIES AND SERVICES

- Capacity: 14 anglers
- Rooms: 11 total: 8 with Single King/Queen size beds and 3 Doubles with 2 king/queen size beds. All have air conditioning and private bathrooms.
- **Pool:** Kick back with a drink in your hand to enjoy the view.
- Main Lodge: Dining room, sitting room, bar and fully equipped fly-tying table.
- Telephone and Wifi Available
- **Meals:** Beautifully prepared Bahamian specialties concentrating on magnificent fresh seafood.
- Full Daily Maid Service and Laundry Service available.
- **Fly Shop:** is fully equipped with flies, rods, reels, lines, selected items of flats wear and local crafts.
- Non-Fishing Activities include snorkeling, kayaking, diving and golf.

THE FISHING

- Located inside Marls National Park just walk onto the dock and board your skiff!
- Bonefish are the main target, but be prepared for juvenile Tarpon, large Permit and ample Barracuda shots.
- Seasonal Offshore Fishing can be arranged including Wahoo, Tuna, Dorado, Billfish, Grouper and more.
- Professional, Personable and English-speaking Fly-Fishing Guides.
- New Maverick Skiffs, powered by Yamaha engines the fastest, cleanest fleet on the island.
- Majority of the fly fishing is done from the Skiff, but wading opportunities exist.
- Runs to the flats vary from 10 to 45 minutes.
- A catch-and-release fishery.

NON ANGLERS:

\$ 650 a night + government taxes

NOT INCLUDED:

Transportation to Abaco Island, Transfer from Treasure Cay to the Lodge (\$80 p/person one way), Flies, Gratuities and Government Taxes

PAYMENT TERMS:

Reservations are confirmed with a 50% deposit. All deposits are non-refundable, unless a client replacement is found. Final payment is due 60 days prior to departure. At this point, participants are responsible for total land costs and no refunds will be made for unused land transportation, accommodations or meals.

FISHING

HUNTING

David Denies offers a grand variety of wing shooting sport, including four uniquely beautiful lodges near Cordoba, **Argentina**, the world capital of dove shooting. Three of these Cordoba lodges focus on Dove, while the 4th is focused on Decoyed-Pigeons. Our dove lodges are 10 months of the year from January thru October, meaning you can easily combine for two or three days of world-class dove shooting while you are in Argentina or Chile with your fishing. There are also two majestic mixed bag lodges in **Uruguay**, offering walk up hunting for partridge over pointing dogs, pigeons and doves. Then two more lodges near Buenos Aires: Jacana Lodge hosts duck hunters seeking the best duck hunting on the planet, and Los Crestones, located only 2 hours from Buenos Aires airport (EZE), offer not only ducks, partridge, and dove, but big game as well (Black Buck Antelope & Axis Deer).

BIG GAME

Red Stag Patagonia, outfits some of the best Red Stag hunts in both **Argentina** and **Chile** as well as best free-range Black Buck and Axis Deer hunting in South America. Our four operations are located in Chile, Northern Patagonia, Mendoza and Buenos Aires. All of Red Stag's hunts are fair chase, open country hunts in magnificent terrain, and their success rate speaks for itself.
